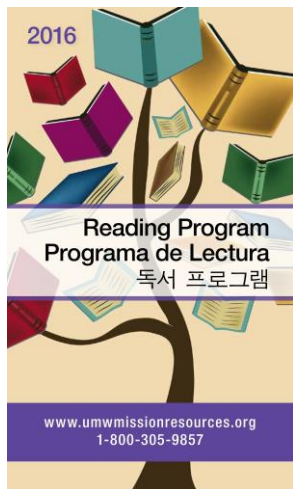

Making Mission Happen: Treasurer's Vault

This has been another generous year of giving from United Methodist Women in the Uwharrie District so far. I am optimistic that we will make our District Pledge of \$83,000.00. Treasurers will be receiving their 4th quarter letter from me around the end of October or the first of November. You will receive a printout of your giving so far this year so that you can check it against your records and see where there may be a possibility for additional giving. Remember that making a pledge to mission and meeting it is a requirement to be a Mission Today unit. The Conference Goal is to increase the percentage of churches giving in all five channels: Pledge, Special Mission Recognition, Gift to Mission, Gift in Memory, World Thank Offering. Let's make a special effort to increase our 54% in 2014 to the largest in the Conference. A \$5 gift in any category is all you need.

I look forward to seeing you at Officers' Leadership Development on November 7th at Salem United Methodist Church. This is very important if you are a new Treasurer, or even if you are a seasoned veteran. There are always changes on remittance forms. With your fourth quarter remittances you will be returning your forms with your mission recipients for 2015—Special Mission Recognition, Gift to Mission, and Gift in Memory. If you need a form, please let me know so that I may send you one with your fourth quarter letter.

I will be turning over the Treasurer position to Diane James. My tenure is up, and I wish I could continue. Diane is a very capable person and will be able to answer any questions. I have enjoyed getting to know a lot of you, even if just by telephone.
