

Happy New Year! I hope each of you had a blessed Christmas and are ready for 2015. I want to share some really good news with you. The Yadkin Valley District met its' pledge of \$163,000 for 2014. I am so proud of our district and want to thank each of you for the contributions that you gave. It took all us working together to achieve this goal. Our total undesignated giving was \$168,341.64. The total designated giving was \$18,437.93. Total giving from the Yadkin Valley District was \$186,779.57. Again, I am so proud but even more important is the number of women, youth and children that will benefit from these monies.

Our pledge for 2015 is remaining the same as 2014. If your local unit has not turned in your pledge form for 2015, please do so as soon as you can. ### Education and Interpretation: Martha Isenberg

Our first major district event is the District Mission Study on March 21. Did you know that attending it will help you meet #4 of the Mission Today criteria?

Sedge Garden United Methodist Church in Kernersville will host our District Mission Study on Saturday, March 21. Mrs. Jennifer Davis will be our study leader for the study on "The Church and People with Disabilities." Mrs. Davis taught this study last summer at Mission U and has lots of information to share with us. She is director of Discipleship Ministry for WNCC-UMC and is a much sought-after motivational speaker.

The intent of this study is to build awareness in the church regarding issues around disability, to call the church to provide full accessibility to services and opportunities, and to promote advocacy for justice for people with disabilities. People with typical bodies can be thought of as temporarily able-bodied because disabilities can happen to anyone at any time. So this is a topic that all of us need to know about to help us be prepared to help our church be inclusive to all, regardless of disabilities.

Included in this letter is a registration form and directions to Sedge Garden UMC. Our hands on mission project for this event is monetary donations with 50% for undesignated giving and 50% for Bethlehem Center. Make checks payable to the Yadkin Valley District UMW. 






**Program Resources: Debra Lawson**

**Meal Information:**

The room rate that shows on your confirmation letter is the room rate only, meals are an additional cost. Meals are optional for all facilities other than the Terrace Hotel or the Lambuth Inn. Guests staying in optional meal facilities may purchase a 3 meal package at the same cost of \$32.00 per person for each 3 consecutive meals or individual meals can be purchased: \$9.50 for breakfast, \$11.50 for lunch and \$14.00 for dinner. Children 6 through 11 years of age receive meals at half price, 5 years of age and under eat free. **Meal package of \$32.00 per person, per day will automatically be added for each person staying in the Terrace Hotel or the Lambuth Inn (dinner on day of arrival, breakfast and lunch the next day).**

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
