From the North:

Going South on I-77, take exit 19B to Interstate 485 (Outer toward Spartanburg). Take exit 21 for North Carolina 24/Harris Blvd. (first exit on I-485) Turn right onto W THarris Blvd. After 1/2 mile, W THarris ends at Mt. Holly-Huntersville Road. Turn right onto Mt. Holly-Huntersville Rod. Church is 1/4 mile on the right.

From the South:

Going North on I-77, take exit 18 (W T Harris Blvd.); Turn left (west) on WTHarris Blvd. Go 1.9 miles to Mt. Holly-Huntersville Rd. Church is 1/4 mile on right.

From the West:

Traveling East on I-85, take exit 30 toward Interstate 485; keep left at the fork, follow signs for Interstate 485 North toward Statesville. Take exit 21 for North Carolina 24/ WT Harris Blvd; Go 1/2 mile; W THarris ends at Mt. Holly-Huntersville Rd. Turn right. Church is 1/4 mile on right.

From the East:

Traveling West on I-85, take exit 38 to merge onto I-77 N/US-21 North toward Statesville. Go 5.2 miles on I-77, take exit 18 (WTHarris Blvd.). Turn left (west) on WT Harris Blvd.. Go 1.9 miles to Mt Holly-Huntersville Rd. W T Harris ends) Turn right. Church is 1/4 mile on 1/4 mile

From I-85 North:

Take Billy Graham Exit, which becomes Woodlawn Road as it crosses I-77. Continue Woodlawn Road to Selwyn Avenue; take a left on Selwyn and continue past Queens College and Meyers Park Baptist Church at the light; Selwyn becomes Queens Road. Church is on right (just past Oxford & before next light).

From I-77 North:

Take Woodlawn Road exit to Selwyn Avenue; left on Selwyn and continue past Queens College and Myers Park Baptist Church at the light; Selwyn becomes Queens Road. Church is on right (just past Oxford & before next light).

From I-85 South:

I-85 to I-77 South. South on I-77; take the Morehead Street exit. Turn left on Morehead, continue 3 miles. Church is located at the intersection of Queens and Providence Roads.

From I-77 South:

Take the Morehead Street Exit. Turn left on Morehead continue for 3 miles. Church is located at the intersection of Queens and Providence Roads.







Event lodging reservation deposit – Due 60 or more days prior to the event – Deposit amount is equal to the first nights lodging and is due at the time of reservation. Meal Information:

The room rate that shows on your confirmation letter is the room rate only, meals are an additional cost. Meals are optional for all facilities other than the Terrace Hotel or the Lambuth Inn.
