President's Report for 2019

Throughout 2019, Northern Piedmont UMW celebrated the 150 years that United Methodist Women and its predecessor organizations have been at work putting faith, hope and love into action for women, children and youth. Units all over the District had parties and celebrations in their local churches from March until the end of the year. Some events were major affairs, like the formal historical sit-down tea at Fairfield UMC, and some were small get-togethers at church after a Sunday morning worship. On March 23, 2019, the District hosted a very well-attended UMW birthday party (cake and ice cream included) at Bennett College in Greensboro, showcasing our local National Mission Institution and having a good time while doing it. Rev. Maria King gave our mission message, and Rev. Tamara Ingram gave a testimonial about the impact of UMW on her life and ministry.

Our lead-in event that day was a Social Action Workshop focused on maternal and child health. Presenters from two groups (Moms Rising and Healthy Moms, Healthy Babies) shared valuable information we could take back to our units. Our hands-on missions project for the workshop was to bring baby items and things needed for new mothers, all to be donated to the local group, Moms Rising. Our many donations had an estimated value of \$350.

We have continued to support Mission around the globe and close to home. Through the generous giving of women in this District, UMCOR received kits and monetary donations totaling \$5,729.50. We even received and sent 9 sewing kits to the Mission Resource Center, but we did not calculate what that value was. We donated 61 shoe boxes for Project Agape along with \$85 in cash and checks, amounting to a value of \$2,220. At our District Annual Celebration, we collected \$250 worth of non-perishable food items plus \$45 in cash, all of which we donated to the Spartan Food Pantry at College Place UMC, which serves needy students and others in the UNC-Greensboro area.

As always, and like UMW throughout its history, our Northern Piedmont District worked hard and had a relatively successful year in 2019.

- We had 54 units give in all five channels, up from 47 units in 2018.
- We had 30 Mission Today units in the District, 3 more than the previous year.
- Twenty-nine units reported earning Justice Today recognition: 5 Gold, 7 silver and 18 bronze. This represents
 an increase in the total number of Justice Today units, and we certainly applaud the efforts being made by our
 members in this area. We hope this number continues to increase.
- We had 100 members participate in the Reading Program, reading a total of 685 books! As expected, the majority of readers (76) participated in Plan 1, but 4 conscientious women completed Plan 4. It was surprising to notice that no unit reported any activity in the Children's Reading category. With a District membership of over 3,300, we hope to encourage many more ladies to join in the UMW Reading Program.
- As for Mission studies, 28 members studied Practicing Resurrection: The Gospel of Mark and Radical
 Discipleship, 17 participated in the Conference study on Women United for Change, 78 reported studying What
 About Our Money? at Mission u or our District Mission Study, and 115 participated in some other study. This
 indicates our ladies are seriously interested in being educated for Mission!

We applaud our successes as we look forward to doing even better in the future. **Our year-end**membership summary does show some cause for concern. We began 2019 with a total of 3,578 members and ended the year with 3,318, with 84 lost to death. This represents 115 local units and 1 District member. While we added 101 new members, we had a net loss of over 300 members. Many units reported that most of their members are senior citizens, and it's getting harder to stay active. One unit is closing because their church is closing, and another reported that they were closing at the end of 2019 because they could not get anyone to serve as their officers. This is disheartening, but we continue to maintain contact with these ladies (and with other less than active units) to encourage them to re-join us in our PURPOSE: "The organized unit of United Methodist Women shall be a community of women whose purpose is to know God and to experience freedom as whole person through Jesus Christ, to provide a creative, supportive fellowship, and to expand concepts of Mission through participation in the global ministries of the church."

Standing Rules

ARTICLE VII. RULES OF ORDER FOR THE DISTRICT UNITED METHODIST WOMEN ANNUAL CELEBRATION

SECTION 1 GENERAL INFORMATION

Meetings shall open and close at the times stipulated in the official program.

SECTION 2 NEW BUSINESSES

- A. All new business that has not been considered by the Executive Committee of the District shall be presented in writing to the Secretary seven (7) days prior to being considered by the voting delegates.
- B. Proposed resolutions must be submitted in writing to the District President sixty (60) days prior to the beginning of the District Annual Celebration.

SECTION 3 MOTIONS

- A. All motions except on matters of procedure shall be written and signed by the maker and furnished to the Chair before action is taken.
- B. The Secretary, unless directed otherwise, shall not record motions ruled out of order, points of order on which no appeal is taken or trivial matters of privilege.

SECTION 4 DEBATES

- A. In seeking recognition from the Chairperson, a member must stand to address the Chair and, on being recognized, state her or his name before making comment or motion.
- B. The maker of a motion, in preference to any other delegate, shall be entitled to the floor immediately after the motion is stated.
- C. Debate shall be limited to fifteen (15) minutes per topic.
- D. No member shall speak to a motion a second time until all others have been given the opportunity to speak.
- E. No member shall speak more than twice on the same questions, nor more than two (2) minutes at one time, without the consent of the body.
- F. General consent shall be required if additional time is to be given.

SECTION 5 VOTING MEMBERSHIP

The voting body of the Northern Piedmont District shall be composed of local unit members in attendance.

SECTION 6 QUORUM

A quorum shall be a simple majority of the membership present representing the units in the District.

ARTICLE VIII. PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised Edition shall be the parliamentary authority. A two-thirds vote of the members present is required to suspend or amend these rules.
