**-- FROM MARTHA ISENBURG, *Yadkin Valley District UMW President* --**

Even though 2020 was an extremely challenging year, United Methodist Women in our district met the challenge and learned new ways of staying connected and true to our Purpose. It has been heartening to read the “End of Year Reports” from units and see that most have continued to meet in a safe way either by phone, on-line or socially distanced outside. And you have still done mission projects and continued to send in mission money because you know our mission institutions are continuing to work to meet the needs of women, children and youth.

We were fortunate that our first district event, the mission study, was able to be held before the close down created by the pandemic. It was held March 7 at Oak Forest UMC with 123 attending. Tonya Lanier was the study leader for “Women United for Change--150 Years in Mission.” The hands-on project was gift cards that were sent to Deaconess Cindy Johnson at the southern Texas border to buy supplies needed by the immigrants she assists. 46 gift cards were collected with a value of \$958 and \$1,213 was collected in an offering for undesignated giving.

Our Prayer Breakfast and “Wear a Hat, Bring a Hat Membership Tea” were not able to be held due to meeting restrictions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. We launched into cyberspace and had our first District Annual Celebration by Zoom on August 27 with 103 registered and 73 attending. We were able to conduct needed business and elect officers by a polling process and Mary Jo Brewer installed them. The annual program book with highlights of unit activities was made available as a handout on the Conference UMW web site. Sue Couch shared an inspiring memorial service, “Keep His Light Shining,” to remember those who had passed away in 2019, since we were not able to have the Prayer Breakfast. The hands-on project was to send gift cards for books for the children at Bethlehem Center. \$640 in gift cards was delivered there, along with 70 new books and about 30 gently used books.

Leadership Development Day was also held by Zoom on November 14 with 51 from our district attending. We met jointly with all districts in the conference before being split into breakout rooms by districts. All handouts for officers and end of year report forms were available at the Conference web site so members could print what they needed. Positive comments on evaluations were that they had a broader perspective by hearing what all the officers did, instead of just their leadership position. With our hands-on project, \$150 was collected for Project Agape.

Even under adverse conditions, we were flexible and made a strong impact as we continued to live out our purpose and move into the next 150 years in mission.
