President's Report for 2020

UMW members of the Northern Piedmont District, when we look back over this past year, with all its struggles and disruptions, let's take the time to remember that we are God's people and we are blessed! God is still on the throne and God is still in the miracle-working business!

Shelter-in-place orders, shuttered churches, worship at home and in parking lots, countless Zoom meetings, job losses for some, and yes, even sickness and death for some of our loved ones: these were the facts of our lives during 2020. **Through it all, we United Methodist Women in the Northern Piedmont District, like others all over the world, continued to put our faith and trust in our Lord Jesus Christ, and to work to put faith, hope, and love in action for women, children and youth.**

The 2020 year-end reports from our local units lifted my spirits, even in the midst of such unprecedented struggle. I was so encouraged by how much UMW members were able to accomplish in an admittedly difficult year. Many units found creative ways to hold their monthly meetings and even to hold fundraising events! You put together school kits and collected other needed items for local schools, as well as for UMCOR. You contributed to and worked with so many local projects in your areas. You attended our virtual District and Conference events.

Here is a brief summary of our activities in 2020:

- We had 37 units participating in all Five Channels of Mission Giving. The District has 94 active units so this represents 39.4% of our units. Although this number is down from the 54 units in this category in 2019, we praise God for all these faithful units, and for every unit in this District.
- Twenty-one (21) units reported participation in at least one Mission Study in 2020, with over 100 ladies studying "Finding Peace in an Anxious World," "Practicing Resurrection" and "the School-to-Prison Pipeline".
- Thirty-one (31) units earned Mission Today Status: 19 gold units, 5 silver units and 7 bronze units. This actually represents an increase of one unit over the previous year!
- Twenty-three (23) units attained some level of Justice Today status: 4 gold, 5 silver and 14 bronze. This is six fewer units than in 2019.
- Twenty (20) units reported that their ladies participated in the Reading Program: 55 completing Plan I, 15 in Plan II, 5 in Plan III and 5 in Plan IV. That's a total of 80 readers across all plans, 20 readers less than last year. No unit reported any readers in the Children's Reading category.



Like every other UMW District in our Western North Carolina Conference, our membership numbers went down in 2020. A careful review of our records found that we actually had 94 active units at the beginning of the year rather than the 115 we had previously reported. Three (3) units reported being inactive, and we had one member who was not a member of a unit. In January of 2020 we had a total of 3,388 members. We added 71 members during the year while losing 438 members, 69 of whom passed away. At the end of the year, our membership was 2,950. Our membership has steadily declined over the last several years and the COVID-19 pandemic has certainly not helped with our efforts at retention and growth.

Units frequently reported difficulty in staying active. I heard many of the following comments: "We haven't met in person since March," or "We are a small unit," and "Most of our members are getting old, or "It'll take a miracle to keep this unit going." Well, as I said earlier, we serve a miracle-working God, and God has kept us going! **Our numbers may be off from where they once were, but we are still hard at work. I am grateful that we United Methodist Women have held true to our PURPOSE as a creative, supportive fellowship, and that we have continued to support the global ministries of the church.** Going forward, we can each invite other women to join us.

I am committed to continued service with this very talented Northern Piedmont District mission team (and with you, of course)! Each of us has made a commitment to United Methodist Women, but more importantly, we've made a commitment to God. **I pledge that each day we will work to help you be the very best UMW member and unit you can be. We will continue to serve the LORD!**

Standing Rules

ARTICLE VII. RULES OF ORDER FOR THE DISTRICT UNITED METHODIST WOMEN ANNUAL CELEBRATION

SECTION 1 GENERAL INFORMATION

Meetings shall open and close at the times stipulated in the official program.

SECTION 2 NEW BUSINESSES

A. All new business that has not been considered by the Executive Committee of the District shall be presented in writing to the Secretary seven (7) days prior to being considered by the voting delegates.

B. Proposed resolutions must be submitted in writing to the District President sixty (60) days prior to the beginning of the District Annual Celebration.

SECTION 3 MOTIONS

A. All motions except on matters of procedure shall be written and signed by the maker and furnished to the Chair before action is taken.

B. The Secretary, unless directed otherwise, shall not record motions ruled out of order, points of order on which no appeal is taken or trivial matters of privilege.

SECTION 4 DEBATES

A. In seeking recognition from the Chairperson, a member must stand to address the Chair and, on being recognized, state her or his name before making comment or motion.

B. The maker of a motion, in preference to any other delegate, shall be entitled to the floor immediately after the motion is stated.

C. Debate shall be limited to fifteen (15) minutes per topic.

D. No member shall speak to a motion a second time until all others have been given the opportunity to speak.

E. No member shall speak more than twice on the same questions, nor more than two (2) minutes at one time, without the consent of the body.

F. General consent shall be required if additional time is to be given.

SECTION 5 VOTING MEMBERSHIP

The voting body of the Northern Piedmont District shall be composed of local unit members in attendance.

SECTION 6 QUORUM

A quorum shall be a simple majority of the membership present representing the units in the District.

ARTICLE VIII. PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised Edition shall be the parliamentary authority.

A two-thirds vote of the members present is required to suspend or amend these rules.
