## **Treasurer's Note**

Dear Catawba Valley Treasurers:

You have had a lousy District Treasurer this year. In my defense, I have a sick husband and I have had multiple computer and printer problems. I have had difficulty getting my hands on enough Gift in Memory cards to satisfy all of you. My husband seems to be getting better and my computer problems seem to be behind me so I'm hoping that my performance will improve this last quarter of the year.

For third quarter we had \$7,987.31 given in undesignated funds. Other giving was to the Legacy Fund, \$435.00. Several remittances were received too late for me to post them in third quarter. That was probably my fault for not sending you my usual letter. Year to date our giving has been \$32,270.38 in undesignated funds which is a good bit off of our \$80,000 goal. Consequently, we lowered the budget for next year to \$60,000. If we lose any more churches, even that modest goal will be difficult.

I'm available to meet with your units to any of our financial reporting or goals. Just email or text me to make an appointment. It would be helpful to me if it could be a daytime meeting because I don't drive at night. That may change because my cataract surgery last month seems to have improved by vision considerably.

The new tools and programs that will rollout throughout 2022 include:

- A new, easier to navigate website. The new website will have a homepage designed to pique the interest of women new to our organization and start them on a journey to membership. The homepage will also include a special portal where members can log in to access resources specially designed for them.
- **Templates for Soul Care retreats**. A pilot member recruitment program will be debuted through which current members invite nonmember friends to themed retreats specially designed to nurture our bodies, minds and souls.
- **Innovations to Mission u.** Beginning in 2022, Mission u will be introducing new curricula each year—one for children, one for youth and one for adults—all focused on a shared biblical theme that incorporates spiritual growth, contemporary issues and how these show up in various geographic areas.
