A NOTE FROM OUR TREASURER:

Greetings to UWF units in our District. Now is the time for us to continue our work for 2023. If you have not submitted the information card, please send your 2023 Pledge, President, and Treasurer information to me for my records.

Remember that to be recognized as a *Mission Today Unit*, you must make and meet your pledge. We must give in all five mission channels: Pledge to Mission, Special Recognition Pin, Gift to Mission cards, Gift in Memory cards, and the World Thank Offering. Our *2023 Conference Financial Goal* this year is to increase our giving to the World Thank Offering by 10%.

Our Pledge for 2022 was \$41,500 and our giving was \$34,575.95—a drop of \$6,924.05. Our Pledge for 2023 is \$39,000. Let's set a goal that we will meet this Pledge this year.


Two Virtual Events in 2023? Why?!

We can invite speakers and other event participants from all over the country (or world!).




"OK, but I still really like in-person gatherings. Nothing beats the energy of United Women in Faith members gathered in the same space, and I enjoy hands-on activities."


