

#### Important Message Concerning United Methodist Church Disaffiliations

June 17-20 the Western Conference of the UMC held its Annual Conference. It was a happy time as well as a sad time for the delegates, both lay and clergy as we went about completing the task of Disaffiliation for a total of 195 churches in our conference. In addition, the Western Conference also closed another 5 churches because of large declines in membership, worship attendance, and/or financial support. That is a loss of 200 churches.

Sadly 40 of those 200 churches are in the Catawba Valley District, and many of you in those churches may be unaware that you <u>can continue as members of the UWF.</u> Since the United Women in Faith is an entirely separate entity from the United Methodist Church, you can keep your unit intact, leaving everything as is (just let me know the new name of your church).

If, however, you decide to disband your unit (we hope you don't), individuals who still wish to remain in association with UWF can join just the UMF at another unit and remain a member of your current if you desire. There is also something called an <u>independent member</u>. I will be sending a separate email with information about remaining UWF, which explains all this.

There is a full list of the Catawba Valley District's disaffiliated and recently closed churches on page 5. We are asking the Presidents to reach out to these churches that are near your church and offer their members a UWF home if their unit will be disbanding.

#### READING PROGRAM

This month I am reviewing a new book on our Reading List. Phoebe. A Story, written by Paula Gooder. She is a British Theologian and Anglican Lay Leader who is well published. She has taught at several Theological Colleges including Oxford Seminary, concentrating on New Testament particularly.

All this is background to encourage reading of this book. Per Paula, this is not a historical novel. My lack of knowledge thinks it is. Several little lessons are hidden within the pages. One is on what prayer is and is not. This is a fascinating day to day of ancient Rome in the early years of the Church. We see the hardships of the people, arguments of Theology, and growth and understanding in the early Church. These items are still within our Church now, both in seasoned members as well as new persons beginning their walk with God. We see personable versions of Paul, Phoebe, Peter and other leaders only mentioned in what we read in our version of the Bible.

Reading the book is an easy read, but the Notes section, in the back, gives a lot of insight into the Theology as well as explanations of the world of ancient Rome and the early Church. The way she has penned Phoebe, a Story really makes me want to read some of the other books she has written.
