I pray for all of our individuals/communities who suffered and continue to suffer as a result of this terrible disaster.

During October and November, we in North America celebrate the harvest. Monday, October 14 was Canada's Thanksgiving Day; ours is just around the corner. In a sense, October and November are harvest months for United Women in Faith (UWFaith). We wrap up our District and Conference activities by mid-November, and all of our District financial obligations and gifts must be sent to Martha Phillips by December 1.



### **Membership Nurture and Outreach**

Fall is here, although we did not expect it to arrive in the dramatic form of Hurricane Helene. The devastation is not something we will soon forget, and many of you may still be in a state of flux. However, it certainly has been amazing and heartwarming to see so many people from around the United States and Canada step up to help out Western North Carolina with resources and volunteers. The United Women in Faith are all about missions—we just did not expect our region to become a recipient of mission funds this fall.

This is a crucial time to check on your nurturing partners. Some of the United Methodist church buildings in the Blue Ridge District suffered severe damage from flooding and downed trees. I saw firsthand the destruction left behind at Old Fort United Methodist Church when as much as four feet of water filled the church, dumping as much as twelve inches of silt in the sanctuary. It was heartbreaking for me to see, and even more so for that congregation.

By now you probably have checked on the members in your unit to be sure everyone is safe and that they have what they need. If you have extra funds in your treasury, it is also a great time to pull your unit together and see where you can best help with local needs. For instance, so many schools in western North Carolina were flooded—can you donate classroom supplies to a nearby school? There are still so many employees here from other areas working on power lines and water systems—can your unit organize a meal for them? This is a momentous time for your unit to reach out to help our shaken but strong region.

Greetings Ladies,

Thank you for your generous donations to our Pledge to Mission and all other undesignated giving in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter of 2024. Total undesignated Mission Giving was \$20,917.50. This included \$4,135.00 raised through Walk for Mission. Remember undesignated giving all goes toward our 2024 District Pledge to Mission.

Year to date we have given \$46,510.55 toward our pledge of \$82,100.00. This is 57 percent of our pledge for the year. Normally we expect the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter to be our biggest in giving. This will be a real challenge this year.
